<b>AWARDS</b>	All wrestlers must be pre-registered on or by Thursday evening at 10:00 pm prior to the tournament. Club directors or individual members will login into their personal account to register. All wrestlers must be a MYWA member in order to compete in any MYWA sanctioned event. <b>AGE GROUPS</b>	<b>Age Groups are determined by year of birth. (A wrestlers birthday as of December 31, 2010)</b> Proof of age will be required if wrestler is challenged within the first two rounds of competition. A birth certificate is the only form of validation that will be accepted.
<b>RULES</b>	<b><u>Modified High School Rules</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must be in grade 8<sup>th</sup> or under. Anyone born in 94 must send proof they're in 8<sup>th</sup> when registering for MYWA.</li> <li>• All Michigan residents 8<sup>th</sup> grade and under <b>MUST</b> be a MYWA member to compete in post season events.</li> <li>• Age Groups 06-04, 03-02: three, 1 minute periods</li> <li>• Age Groups 01-00, 99-98, 97-96 (95 8<sup>th</sup> grade only): three, 1 1/2 minute periods</li> <li>• Singlets or t-shirt and shorts are required.</li> <li>• One step on scale at weigh-ins</li> <li>• Mouth guards <b>Mandatory</b> for wrestlers with braces</li> <li>• Hair caps attached to headgear <b>Mandatory</b> for wrestlers not groomed to HS standards. (Hair length must be above eyebrow, earlobes, and collar.)</li> <li>• If less than three wrestlers are in a weight class, the tournament has the right to move them up one weight class (in the same age group) except for heavyweight.</li> </ul>
